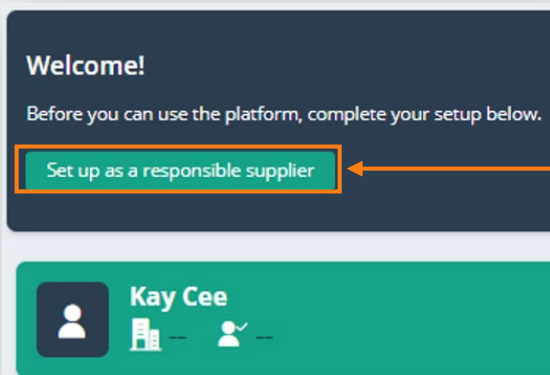


NEW RESPONSIBLE SUPPLIER

Registration as a Responsible Supplier is necessary to meet the requirements of the EESS and ACMA. The person in the Responsible Supplier organisation who does this will be the Authorised Officer. This person will be responsible for complying with all legislative requirements. They must reside in Australia (if registering as responsible supplier in Australia) or New Zealand (if registering as responsible supplier in New Zealand). The Authorised Officer will have sufficient seniority to ensure the supplying requirements are met and completes the declaration

Once you have completed creating your individual account (see [Setting up yourself on the EESS Platform in the Learning guides](#)) and selected how you intend to use the platform, when you log in again you will see a 'Welcome' message top left of your screen. Below this will be a button to set up your business

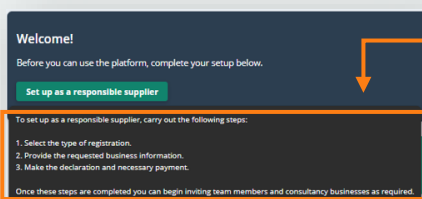
The Authorised Officer should set up their business in the EESS Platform and then invite team members to join the platform



This button will reflect the intent to use the platform as previously selected

If you are registering with EESS and on the EESS platform for the first time, the following steps will apply:

1. Enter the requested business information
2. Type of registration - EESS / EESS&ACMA / ACMA
3. Business address
4. Review
5. Declaration
6. Payment



Hovering over the button will remind you of the key next steps to set up your business

To start setting up your business

- Click on the button

STEP 1: Enter the business information


- Select the Country using the dropdown
- Once you enter the correct ABN/NZBN* click on the **Refresh** button.
- The Business & Trading name fields will auto populate according to the details associated with the ABN/NZBN
- **Note:** if New Zealand is selected, your IRDN is required
- For country code type a + then select the correct code from the list
- Enter your business phone number
- Enter a business email address**
- Click the **Continue** button to go to the next screen

*ABN/NZBN: The Australian or New Zealand Business Number associated with the Responsible Supplier.

IRDN: Inland Revenue Department Number for New Zealand companies.

Note: It is mandatory for a responsible supplier to be based in Australia or New Zealand and have an ABN or IRDN

** it is advised the business email address be generic such as: **infoequip@xyzcompany.com** and not an individual's email address as that person may leave the organization at some point


Note: the Breadcrumbs at the top of the screen will show you where you are in the process

Please note: An annual registration fee is payable for EESS responsible supplier registration.

If you do not include EESS in your selection above, you will not have registered for **electrical safety** requirements and as such you cannot sell in-scope equipment into States and Territories that apply the EESS.

If you are not the Authorised Officer for the business you are about to register, you should select **Withdraw** (from the actions menu) and arrange for the Authorised Officer to undertake the registration process.

An Authorised Officer must be the Director of a company or a senior member of the staff of a Responsible Supplier who has delegated responsibility from management for electrical safety and/or regulatory compliance. The Authorised Officer is an Australia or New Zealand located senior level employee, or owner, of the Responsible Supplier business. Typical titles for Authorised Officer would be 'Director', 'General Manager', 'Senior Compliance Director', 'Senior Compliance Manager', 'Business Owner'.

STEP 5: Declaration


You will be asked to make a declaration confirming the equipment supplied is electrically safe and meets all relevant electrical safety standards.

A Responsible Suppliers Declaration is a declaration of compliance with either the EESS and/or the ACMA schemes, made when registering on the platform.

Please read the Declaration carefully

Note: the Declaration screen will differ depending on the Registration Type you selected in Step 2. The example below is for EESS and ACMA registration type

I declare that:

- (1) I, A Kay, am the authorised officer who has been authorised to make this declaration on behalf of EXAMPLE PTY LTD.
- (2) This declaration relates to electrical equipment for which EXAMPLE PTY LTD is the manufacturer in Australia or New Zealand or is the entity who is the importer of the equipment into Australia or New Zealand.
- (3) All electrical equipment supplied will be electrically safe and meet relevant standards at the time the equipment is imported or manufactured. Specifically, that:
 - (a) each item of a type of level 1 in-scope electrical equipment when sold by the responsible supplier will—
 - (i) meet the relevant standard for the type as in force at the time the item was manufactured in Australia or New Zealand, or imported into Australia or New Zealand by the responsible supplier; and
 - (ii) be electrically safe.
 - (b) each item of a type of level 2 or level 3 in-scope electrical equipment when sold by the responsible supplier will—
 - (i) be registered in the national register;
 - (ii) meet the relevant standard for the type as at the time the item was registered in the national register; and
 - (iii) be electrically safe.
- (4) All equipment supplied will comply with the EESS and relevant electrical safety laws.
- (5) There is a current certificate of conformity for each plug, flexible supply cord or appliance connector, as defined in AS/NZS 4417 (Regulatory compliance mark for electrical and electronic equipment), sold for use with the item (where applicable). Note: cords may have HAR mark in lieu of a certificate of conformity.
- (6) When registering level 2 or level 3 in-scope electrical equipment on the national register the Responsible Supplier's authorised officer or authorised representative will make an equipment declaration.

The first screen shows the amount owed


- Click on the **Submit** button to go to the Select Payment Method screen






Select Payment Method

 - Confirmation that you have been set up as a Responsible Supplier
 - A message to say that you are registered as a Responsible Supplier stating the registration type. The message will ask you to log off and log on again
 - An email confirming your registration which will have the declaration and tax invoice attached

Note: All EESS fees do not include GST and once payment is processed, a receipt will be issued

STEP 6: Make payment

BPAY

If you selected BPAY, the Biller Code and payment details will appear. These details are essential to process the payment with your Bank



Log off the EESS Platform and process the payment with your Bank

Please note the following instructions carefully:

- Please use the below Biller Code and Reference Number to complete your payment using BPAY from your bank channel.
- Make sure to correctly populate the Biller Code, Reference Number and the exact Payment Amount, else the payment will fail.
- Please initiate BPAY payment through your bank channel only after you have clicked on the 'Confirm' button on this screen. The Biller Code, Reference Number, Payment Due Date and the exact Payment Amount will still be visible to you after you click the 'Confirm' button.
- The payment needs to be settled within the Payment Due Date on this screen. BPAY payments will be not available after the expiry of this period. You will need to go back to the individual case of each items and add them back to payment cart and initiate a new payment.
- Usually payment verification occurs next business day after payment however there may be up to 3 days delay in payment verification if paying by BPAY.


