## Question

In the definition of an over blanket / duvet / wrap, (d) includes the term 'fabric' in the enclosure. Does this term include materials such as leather, PU leather (fake leather) or other flexible membranes that are not woven textiles?

#### Over blanket / Duvet / Wrap

An electrical appliance that—

- (a) is for application of heat to a person by placing or draping over the person;
- (b) is flexible;
- (c) does not contain any heated liquid;
- (d) has a fabric enclosure; and
- (e) has a projected surface area exceeding 0.6 m<sup>2</sup>;

and includes-

(f) any associated power supply or controller.

Yes, fabric is regarded in the broadest terms.
